

Does God Allow # 2

Hello everyone. Welcome to "Notes from the Presence." Today we continue on - does God allow? In our last article, we talked about the source of good, today we are going to focus on the source of evil and why it is on our planet.

However, we rebelled against the kingdom of heaven and God let us have what we demanded - our independence. Now, we live on an earth devoid of the influence of heaven. We were the foolish ones here. Because of our transgression, a bitter curse was released upon our earth. We also turned the ruling power of our world over to an evil spirit force who hates the God who created our world, hates His sons and daughters, and will do anything he can to wreak havoc in our environment. The curse has created all kinds of mutations, viruses, sickness, weakness, foolishness, and disaster.
